

## Romanian Cash Rebate System 2024

### New call for projects 25<sup>th</sup> July 2024

#### General terms

Cash rebate is 30% of the eligible Romanian spend.

- This state aid scheme has a multiannual character and runs until 31 December 2026 (to be extended) covering a maximum of **30%** of the eligible expenditure of film production performed on the territory of Romania.
- The state aid granted under this scheme consists of non-reimbursable financial allocations.
- **Minimum Romanian spend:**  
The total amount of eligible expenditure in connection with the implementation of the project is at least:
  - 100,000 Euro for feature films (over 60 mins);
  - 100,000 Euro / episode for series;
  - 50,000 Euro for documentary films;
  - 15,000 Euro for short films, animation films with a duration of at least 5 mins, or animation series
- **Cap per project: 10 million Euro as maximum value of the state aid**  
Annual budget cap is the equivalent to 50 million Euro (if the annual budget allocated to the state aid scheme has been exhausted, applications for financing agreements which have not been allocated within the annual budget will be funded from the budget of the following year, if they are approved)

#### Type of productions that can benefit of cash rebate

- **SERVICE PRODUCTIONS** with the involvement of a registered Romanian film production company, based on a service agreement
- **CO-PRODUCTIONS**, either European or other international with financial and/or creative participation of a Romanian co-producer, based on a co-production agreement
- **ROMANIAN FILMS**
- All projects shall meet the **cultural test** criteria ("cultural product" eligibility test) which follows the usual European cultural tests.
- All film categories qualify: short, medium and long fiction films, television series and mini-series, films intended for direct video or internet distribution or any other type of support, artistic documentaries, animation movies;
- The work must be **publicly released within a maximum of 5 years** from the last day of shooting in Romania, proved by sending to the Film Office a private link and a screenshot of the credit of the audiovisual work, mentioning the following text: *"Film made with the support of the Government of Romania"*.

#### Exclusions:

Commercials, TV sitcoms, reality shows, daily soaps, audiovisual works with electoral, political or religious propaganda; sporting events, games or competitions; talk shows; demonstrative programs for different hobbies or projects; lifestyle programs, free programs (without scenario), video games are excluded, violent and porn films are excluded.

#### Procedure for submission, selection of projects, implementation and payment of state aid:

All documents required at every step are submitted online through the platform <https://app.ofic.ro/>.

#### 1) Register the project with the Film Office:

- ✓ The application form needs to be registered in order to obtain an **Applicant's Eligibility Certificate**;

- ✓ The project must pass the cultural test;
- ✓ After the Film Commission's approval, applicant will receive an Eligibility Certificate, valid for two years;
- ✓ Eligible expenses can be incurred after submission of the registration request (any expenditure incurred after the date of registration will be eligible, if the application will be approved, no need to wait for the Certificate).
- ✓ Work must start within 60 calendar days as of the date Certificate is issued;
- ✓ Shooting must start within 9 months as of the date Certificate is issued.

## 2) Implementation of the project:

- ✓ Applicant will deliver monthly reports to the Film Office on value of local expenditure incurred in relation to the project;
- ✓ Within 60 working days as of the last day of shooting in Romania, applicant submits a Financing Agreement Request, together with updated script and budget;
- ✓ After the Film Commission confirms project continues to meet all eligibility criteria, Financing Agreement is signed;

## 3) Upon completion of the production:

- ✓ Within 9 months as of the Financing Agreement date, payment request must be submitted, together with an audit report (certifying the amount of eligible expenditure actually incurred) and substantiating documents
- ✓ all substantiating documents regarding the expenses are submitted online;
- ✓ the payment request and documentation is reviewed by Film Commission within 60 days as of submission of full documentation;
- ✓ payment is made within 120 calendar days as of the date of the audit & payment request approval;

### Eligible expenses:

- payments made to Romanian companies;
- payments made to local individuals;
- payments made to foreign individuals, subject to withholding tax in Romania;

### Non-eligible expenses:

- payments incurred before registration of the project;
- payments towards foreign companies without Romanian tax residency;
- audit and marketing costs
- VAT
